6. To attend Region Commissioners Conferences, as required, to discuss and advice on matters affecting Environmental Education.
7. To keep abreast with all developments within the sphere of Environmental Education in other Branches of The Scout Association of Australia.
8. To arrange for a panel of advisers internally and externally to assist in Environmental Education training throughout the Branch.
9. To liaise and maintain contact with Environmental Education bodies recognised by The Scout Association of Australia.
10. To be responsible for resource material relating to Environmental Education being made available to all levels of
