GENERAL	The appointment of Branch Adviser (Chaplaincy Support) encourages and supports Regions, Districts and Group Leaders in the integration of the spiritual aspects of the Promise and Law in their Scouting lives.
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FUNCTIONS	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Provide support to the Branch Chaplain.2. Liaise with the Branch Chaplain and other Scout Chaplains and recruit and provide support where requested.3. Provide support to Leaders in developing their own spiritual awareness and incorporating the spiritual into all aspects of Scouting.4. Liaise with members of the Region, District and Group teams on arrangements for religious observances.
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THE PERSON	<p>The Branch Adviser (Chaplaincy Support) is to be:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. In good standing with his/her denomination or faith group.2. Sympathetic to the principles of Scouting as embodied in the Promise and Law and willing to sign the Code of Conduct.3. Ecumenical in outlook and willing to encourage support from Scout Chaplains and their faith groups.
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APPOINTMENT	<p>The conditions of appointment of the Branch Adviser (Chaplaincy Support) are to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Hold the appointment of Branch Adviser (Chaplaincy Support) and to be an Adult Member of the Association.2. Be appointed by the Chief Commissioner on the recommendation of the Branch Chaplain.
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3. Undertake appropriate Adult Leader training within specified time-frames.
 4. Wear Scout Uniform as approved by the Chief Commissioner.

DUTIES

1. Liaise with members of the Region, District and Group teams as appropriate.
 2. Promote the ethos of Scouting at all levels.
 3. Assist on Region training seminars regarding training in "Duty to God" and other aspects of the Promise and Law.
 4. Assist in producing material to assist Leaders in planning (inter faith) Scout Owns.
 5. Liaise with the Scout Chaplains of the Branch when appropriate.
 6. Assist with the encouragement of the recruitment of suitable Chaplains in the Regions.
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
