

Become an accredited First Aid Trainer for Scouts Queensland

Scouts Queensland is currently looking for suitably qualified training team members to deliver and assess first aid training.

Scouts Queensland currently partners with Allens Training and to be an accredited trainer with Allens Training applicants will be required to:

- 1. Hold a Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (TAE40116 Certificate IV in Training & Assessment)
- 2. Hold the HLTAID006 Provide advanced first aid qualification
- 3. Evidence of industry experience and skills (a letter from your Group/District/Region)
- 4. 100 Points of Identification
- 5. Working with children clearance (Positive Blue card)
- 6. Work Referees/Validation of experience (a letter from your Group/District/Region see item 3)
- 7. Video evidence of your training delivery (you can co-deliver on an upcoming course and a video will be made during your training session)
- 8. Public Liability Insurance (Scouts Queensland holds this)
- 9. Declaration regarding the equipment used in training (already covered in the partnership agreement)

Support will be provided to you to complete the above requirements and application to Allens.

All training resources (pre-course learning, course rolls, power point presentations and assessment materials are provided).

For Region Trainers manikins, training defibrillators etc. will need to be sourced locally or purchased through grant or other funding sources.

All trainers will be required to complete annual Professional Development, which is supported, by online courses, workshops and industry seminars (free and paid options)
