

SCOUT SECTION SKILLS 2020

Date: - July 1 to July 31.

Open to: All Scouts (Scout Section) and Leaders across Queensland.

Theme: One World

Theme Song: 'One World' by RedOne and featuring Adelina & Now United.

<u>Cost</u>: \$5.00 for registration, badge & postage.

Where: Your own yard. For those who may live in an apartment be creative and think outside the box.

Length of the Camp: Two nights within the month of July. (Main weekend -3/7/20 - 5/7/20).

<u>Requirements</u>: Set up your camp as you would for a normal camp as best as possible including: a tent, a dining / kitchen preparation area, a small themed gateway, a camp gadget, a personal Scout flag based around the theme that should also include your home Patrol name.

<u>Themed Dinner</u>: On night 2, cook a three course meal for your family based on the theme of 'One World'. Therefore you are free to create a meal from any country in the world except for Australia or your cultural or ancestral background. This is to challenge you just that little bit. Send your family members an invitation for the meal. Dress up in the colours or made up costume from that country. Don't forget the decor for your dinner. In traditional Scout protocol include a grace or a reflection time before the meal.

<u>Badge Work</u>: Set yourself a goal of completing a badge (proficiency badge for those working on the old system) or a Special Interest Award Badge (SIA) for those working on the Achievement Pathways. In a video conference with a 2up OAS youth member you may be able to demonstrate some components of one of your core OAS badges.

<u>Risk Assessment</u>: You will need to complete a simple risk assessment for your camp. Ask you Patrol Leader or Scout Leader to help you with this.

Other Activities:

Contact your Patrol members via a video conferencing format. Perhaps get your whole Unit to meet up on line throughout the day.

Complete 1 of the STEM activities. Refer to the activities on the SSS Major Events Web Site for 2020. You can complete an SIA over the weekend with this. Remember to talk to your Unit Council about your plan.

Contact Scouts in other parts of the state via an online meeting. Perhaps your Unit can do this together. City meets Country.

Join the Branch Commissioner via an online meeting. Details to be provided.

Disco: An on line virtual disco will be organised by Venturer Scouts on Friday July 3, 2020.

Applications: June 1 to June 30.

You will need to register as you do for any major event with Scouts Qld. In the application you will be asked to fill in the usual personal details plus the event specific items. This will include your Scout Group (Formation) and your home Patrol (from the drop down tab).

Competitions:

Entries to these competitions can be sent to the provided email address that will be communicated at a later date in readiness for July.

- (1) Send in photos of your themed meal. Provide details about what it included and from which country it was from.
- (2) Send in photos of your themed gateway. (Modify where necessary to use smaller materials such as dowel or skewers etc.)
- (3) Send in photos of your camp gadgets. (Modify where necessary to use smaller materials such as dowel or skewers etc.)
- (4) Record your best dance moves to the song 'One World' by RedOne featuring Adelina & Now United and send to the provided email address. (A compilation will then be made for distribution and viewing.) Which Scout has the best moves in the State?
