

The Gambling Community Benefit Fund Grant Program provides funding to community groups to enhance their capacity to provide services, leisure activities and opportunities for Queensland communities.

### Round 107 is will open mid September and will close on 31 October 2020.

Grant applications are prepared and submitted through the Department of Justice and Attorney-General's online portal and Queensland Scout Formations are reminded that under QBSI 6.5 (Financial Management – Grants), all grant applications must have the prior approval of the District Commissioner, Region Commissioner and Chief Commissioner and be lodged through the Branch Support Office prior to submission.

Below are the instructions for Queensland Scout Formations wishing to apply to the Gambling Community Benefit Fund. The instructions provide step by step guidance on how to apply for a grant and what information must be contained within your application to be eligible. The instructions have been developed in consultation with the Department of Justice and Attorney-General who have assisted by specifying what information should appear in each section.

All Queensland Scout Formations wishing to apply for a Gambling Community Benefit Fund Grant must first contact the Grants Officer at the Branch Support Office who will register the Formation on the online portal and provide a username and password. Formations with an existing online registration must ensure that the most recent financial information from the Formations audited accounts appears in the organisation details section. ### **Key Points:**

- The Branch Support Office will register all Scout Formations on the online portal and a username and password will be provided on request.
- As the legal entity, The Scout Association of Australia, Queensland Branch Inc. is registered with the Fund as the 'Sponsor Organisation', Individual Queensland Scout Formations are defined as 'Sponsored Entities' by the Fund
- Formations must complete the F2 Checklist to confirm support from the District Commissioner (where applicable) and Region Commissioner.
- Group Leaders must also be aware of and support all grant applications submitted on their behalf.
- For Facility Improvements, please refer to the **F14 Building Approval Process**. Formations must receive 'Approval In Principle' for the project <u>prior</u> to submitting a grant application. All the information requested in the F14 is required by the Grant Fund to support your application, and it is the legal entities responsibility to ensure that the supporting information is obtained. - The Fund will no longer gross up grant awards for GST, therefore you will receive the full value of the grant and where tax invoices are provided you can spend a further 10% as the GST on goods and services can be reclaimed by the Branch Support Office (e.g. \$35,000 grant award will be acquitted with invoices valued at \$35,000 excluding GST therefore the Formation can spend up to \$38,500 including GST).
- Because of the organisations GST status, values entered in the requested items section of the application form must be 'excluding GST'.
- All items requested must be supported by quotes which may be requested by the Fund during the Quality Assurance Audit process.
- The acquittal period for Facility Improvement projects remains at 12 months but for other purchases the acquittal has decreased to 6 months.



- Formations wishing to apply must have completed their current Finance and Property Returns and must not have any un-managed debts.
- Only the Chief Commissioner can complete the application Declaration as being 'legally empowered' to enter into a funding agreement.
- Applications submitted by Queensland Scout Formations without the prior approval of the Chief Commissioner will be rejected and removed from the portal.
- Closing dates for 2020: (29 February, 30 April, 30 June, 31 August, 31 October).

### Instructions for submitting grant applications using the Online Grants Portal

The Gambling Community Benefit Fund (GCBF) allocates funding to not-for-profit community groups to enhance their capacity to provide services, leisure activities and opportunities for Queensland communities. Applications can be submitted for funding between \$500 and \$35,000 and there are five funding rounds in 2020 (29 February, 30 April, 30 June, 31 August and 31 October).

As the legal entity, The Scout Association of Australia, Queensland Branch Inc. is registered with the Fund as the 'Sponsor Organisation'. Individual Queensland Scout Formations are defined as 'Sponsored Entities' by the Fund.

QBSI Section 6.5 (Financial Management – Grants), states that Groups wishing to apply for grant funding must first seek approval from their District Commissioner, Region Commissioner and Chief Commissioner with all applications are to be lodged through the Branch Support Office prior to submission. Only the Chief Commissioner and General Manager are authorised to enter into a Funding Agreement on behalf of the Organisation and therefore the approval of the Chief Commissioner must be sought by all applicants.

You will be asked to provide three referees who should be from <u>outside</u> of Scouting.


They will <u>not</u> be required to provide a letter of support however, they must give permission for their contact details to be included in the application.

Scout Formations are not authorised to submit grant applications without the prior approval of the District Commissioner, Region Commissioner and the Chief Commissioner.

Notify the Grants Officer when you have completed the application and it will then appear on the Sponsors account.

### **Gambling Community Benefit Fund Checklist (F2)**

When notifying the Grants Officer of your intention to apply to the Gambling Community Benefit Fund, please complete the Checklist (F2) to confirm eligibility and approval from the District Commissioner (where applicable) and Region Commissioner. Applications will be reviewed and submitted to the Chief Commissioner for approval once the checklist has been completed.

Applications submitted by Queensland Scout Formations without the prior approval of the Chief Commissioner will be rejected and removed from the portal.
