## ADVENTUROUS ACTIVITY COURSES

## COURSE CANCELLATION FEES AND ASSOCIATED PROCESSES

- If notice is received by 7 days prior to the course - no fee is payable and fees will be refunded either directly to the Group / District / Region account or the individual if paid by credit card.
- If notice is received less than 7 days prior to the course - catering and administration fees are payable with the balance being refunded either directly to the Group / District / Region account or the individual if paid by credit card.
- No notice (i.e. trainee does not attend course) - full fee is payable

- If courses are cancelled by Deputy Chief Commissioner AIS or Branch Commissioner Training & Development - no fee is payable.

If for any reason a Leader considers themselves unable to undertake the activity for physical or medical reason then please advise the Training Department on application for the course. This will allow the course Leader to discuss with the participant what reasonable adjustments are available to enable a Leader to adequately meet the Scouting requirements of this course.

This course is part of the Basic Training for Scout Leaders, Venturer Scout Leaders, Rover Advisers, Rover Scouts and must be completed before attending an Advanced course.

If you wish to apply for Recognition of Proficiency for the BOS course please refer to Basic Outdoor Skills Overview document which can be found under Training in the Members area of Scout Qld Website. When submitting your log book please ensure that the entries demonstrate that you have current competency in the areas covered by this course. There is a fee payable for this process.

## Basic Outdoor Skills Proficiency Course

Pre - Requisite - all e-learning modules listed under the Basic Outdoor Skills area and the Assessment of Proficiency workbook must be completed prior to submitting your application to attend the course. Refer to the Learning and Assessment Plan for more details.

This course is an online Basic Outdoor Skills (BOS) Proficiency course which will be delivered via Zoom. It has been designed to enable demonstration of existing knowledge, experience and proficiency gained through undertaking the BOS e-learning, previous on the job learning and activities prior to this online course.

This course requires participants to have previously establish and maintain a temporary overnight campsite, as well participating in a minimum of two bushwalking activities in a controlled environment (minimum 4 hours walking time across both activities) as well as two navigation activities (use of map and compass) in controlled environments that are of sufficient breadth and duration to demonstrate competency and consistency of performance (these could be part of the bushwalking activities above) and one overnight bushwalk.

This course is part of the Basic Training for Scout Leaders, Venturer Scout Leaders, Rover Advisers, Rover Scouts and must be completed before attending an Advanced course. This course may also be undertaken by Joey Scout Leaders, Cub Scout Leaders and Leader of Adults who can meet the pre-requisite requirements.

If you are new to bushwalking or basic outdoor skills including overnight camping, we highly recommend you undertake the BOS weekend practical course.

When submitting your log book please ensure that the entries demonstrate that you have current competency in the areas covered by this course. There is a fee payable for this process.

## Basic Water Rescue Course

There are pre-requisite e-learning modules for both Leaders and Youth members which need to be completed prior to the submission of the training application. If for any reason a Leader considers themselves unable to undertake the activity for physical or medical reason then please advise the Training Department on application for the course.
