Patrol Supervision

The primary responsibility of Leaders at SSS is the supervision of Patrols from their Troop. While SSS's main focus is Patrol camping we must balance this with our responsibility to ensure they are coping with the conditions, are safe and having a good time. This can be best achieved by visiting your Patrols each day to see how they are going. Offer some words of wisdom but please don't jump in and do everything for them. **You need to sign in at the subcamp headquarters each time you visit them.**

Camping

Leaders will not be camping with the Scouts. All Leaders will be in the area from Chernobyl Glade to the Providore. In planning your tentage please bear in mind the limited space so don't bring a 12 person tent just for yourself.

For those with Auto tents you will need to consider other options as vehicles will not be allowed onto the camping area. Barricades will be in place to prevent vehicles going through onto the camping areas.

Catering

Leaders have the option to cater for themselves during the weekend or to be catered for in the Snow Centre from Friday evening to Monday Lunch. You need to indicate which meals you wish to be catered for on your application.

On Saturday night most Leaders will have been pre-appointed to a Patrol for a gastronomic delight based on the weekend theme and some good company. The Patrol will have contacted you prior to SSS to ascertain any dietary requirements. If you are one of the unfortunate ones that misses out then you will need to provide your own meal on that night. You will be required to judge their meal and set up. Leaders are required to pick up a score sheet at the Providore, to fill it in and drop it into the score box. This is part of the camping competition for the weekend.

Activities

We need all the help we can get running activities to keep this many Scouts busy. On Saturday, Sunday and Monday Leaders will be rostered on activities. Core teams will be on the same activity during the weekend whereas others will be on different activities to give them a broader experience. Leaders will also be asked to contribute towards running and / or supervising night time activities including the disco, wide games and market night. There may also be an opportunity to complete requirements towards skill recognition in Adventurous Activities. You will be able to indicate any areas that you may wish to undertake in your application to attend SSS. This can be used by the organizing committee to allocate you to activities over the weekend.

Other Tasks

On Friday you may be required to help set up dining flies at the providore and the Youth Hub. Please come to the Providore at 12:00 pm. Remember your patrols are responsible for setting up their own campsite.

We may also roster on leaders to help with cleaning facilities including toilets, showers and the Snow Centre.
