



Terra Firma – 4WD Skills Recognition Pathways

General Requirements for all SP, TP and AG pathways

- Hold a Certificate of Proficiency (previous Certificate of Adult Leadership) and
- Hold a Certificate of Appointment in your current role

Safe Participant 4WD:

If you have:

- ✓ Completed Scouts Qld Level 1 4WD course OR completed SISODRV001 (Drive AWD/4WD vehicles on unsealed roads) outside of Scouting
- ✓ Have a logbook with 3 recent entries for driving on an unsealed road. Note the detail expected in a logbook includes your role in the activity, the weather and time of day and information about how the activity went.

Apply for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), to become qualified as a Safe Participant in 4WD.

Trained Participant 4WD:

If you have:

- ✓ Completed a Scouts Qld Level 2 4WD course or completed TLIH3002 (Plan and navigate routes) and TLIB0002 (Carry out vehicle inspections) and TLIC2025 (Operate four-wheel drive vehicle) outside of Scouting.
- ✓ Have a logbook with 3 entries evidencing 4WD drives off road since your course(s) were completed.
- ✓ Have completed the Trained Participant Core Portfolio and units have been issued.

Apply for RPL to become qualified as a Trained Participant in 4WD.

Assistant Guide 4WD:

If you have:

- ✓ Completed Scouts Qld Level 3 4WD course or completed FWPCOT3260 (Recover four-wheel drive vehicles) and MSS024023 (Navigate in Urban, Regional and Remote areas) out of Scouting.
- ✓ Have a logbook with 3 recent entries evidencing 4WD drives in regional or remote areas.
- ✓ Have a logbook showing 3 different recovery techniques in either training or trip situations
- ✓ Can supply a plan and risk assessment for a 4WD trip.
- ✓ Have completed the Assistant Guide Core Portfolio.
- ✓ Hold a current First Aid Certificate

Apply for RPL to become qualified as an Assistant Guide in 4WD.

Guide 4WD:

If you have:

- ✓ Completed a Scouts Qld Guide 4WD course OR completed SISODRV002 (Lead four-wheel driving activities) outside of Scouting.
- ✓ Have a logbook with 3 recent entries evidencing leading 4WD trips.
- ✓ Can supply the plan and risk assessment for one of the 4WD trips you lead.
- ✓ Have completed the Guiding Adventure Program
- ✓ Hold a current First Aid Certificate

Apply for consideration for appointment as a 4WD Guide.

Your log needs to contain a number of columns indicating: Date, Location, Distance, Hours/Days, Role (leader, participant), Group Type (adults, youth), Grade, Terrain (easy, difficult, remote), Season, Weather (hot and dry, cold and wet, etc). Verification name and phone number of a witness to your logged experience.
