



Terra Firma – Pioneering Skills Recognition Pathways

General Requirements for all SP, TP and AG pathways

- Hold a Certificate of Proficiency (previous Certificate of Adult Leadership) and
- Hold a Certificate of Appointment in your current role

Safe Participant Pioneering:

If you have:

- ✓ Attended basic training as a scout or venturer leader, or attended a level 1 Pioneering Course
- ✓ Have a logbook with 3 recent entries. Note the detail expected in a logbook includes your role in the activity, the weather and time of day and information about how the activity went.
- ✓ Can supply a plan and risk assessment for a flagpole higher than 3 metres

Apply for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) process to become qualified as a Safe Participant in pioneering.

Trained Participant Pioneering:

If you have:

- ✓ Attended advanced training as a scout leader, or attended a level 2 Pioneering course
- ✓ Have a logbook with 3 recent entries related to significant structures including:
 - A tower over 3 metres in height; and
 - A bridge spanning greater than 10 metres
- ✓ Can supply a plan and risk assessment for:
 - A tower over 3 metres in height; and
 - A bridge spanning greater than 10 metres
- ✓ Have completed the Trained Participant Core Portfolio

Apply the RPL to become qualified as a Trained Participant in Pioneering.

Assistant Guide Pioneering:

If you have:

- ✓ Attended a level 3 Pioneering course
- ✓ Have a logbook with 3 recent entries related to significant structures including:
 - A tower over 3 metres in height; and
 - A bridge spanning greater than 10 metres
- ✓ Can supply a plan and risk assessment for:
 - A tower over 3 metres in height; and
 - A bridge spanning greater than 10 metres
- ✓ Have completed the Assistant Guide Core Portfolio
- ✓ Hold a current First Aid Certificate

Apply the RPL to become qualified as an Assistant Guide in Pioneering.

Your log needs to contain a number of columns indicating: Date, Location, Pioneering Structure type, Duration, Role (leader, participant), Group Type (adults, youth), Season, Weather (hot and dry, cold and wet, etc). Verification name and phone number of a witness to your logged experience.
