ADVENTUROUS ACTIVITY PROGRAMS

Venturer Scouts and Rovers who wish to increase their skills in the Adventurous activities area or other skills areas can attend these programs. There are prerequisites requirements for attending Adventurous Activities training programs, these can be found on the Training Page of the Scouts Qld web page under Where to Start.

APPLICATIONS

COURSE/PROGRAM CANCELLATION FEES AND ASSOCIATED PROCESSES

- If notice is received by 7 days prior to the course/program - no fee is payable and fees will be refunded either directly to the Group / District / Region account or the individual if paid by credit card.
- If notice is received less than 7 days prior to the course/program - catering and administration fees are payable with the balance being refunded either directly to the Group / District / Region account or the individual if paid by credit card.
- No notice (i.e. trainee does not attend course/program) - full fee is payable
- If courses are cancelled by Deputy Chief Commissioner AIS or Branch Commissioner Training & Development - no fee is payable.
