PURPOSE	The purpose of the role is to support the Branch Commissioner International assist Leaders in implementing into the Youth Program, initiatives from WOSM's Better World Framework

**PRIMARY
RESPONSIBILITIES**

- To advise the Chief Commissioner, Region and Branch Commissioners on methods of introducing initiatives from WOSM's Better World Framework into the youth program, including:
 - Messengers of Peace
 - Scouts of the World Award
 - Dialogue for Peace (KAICIID)
 - Earth Tribe (includes Champions for Nature, Scouts Go Solar and Plastic Tide Turners)
 - Scouts for SDGs
 - Patrimonto
 - HeForShe
- Act as adviser to Scouts Qld on all matters relating to WOSM's Better World Framework.
- Support and advise the Branch Commissioners in relation to Better World Framework initiatives at all levels of the Movement.
- Attend meeting, conferences and events as required including
 - International Team meetings.
 - Project Commissioner Team meetings.
- Report monthly on the activities undertaken to Branch Commissioner Better World Scouting



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- Attend events and forums to demonstrate practical activities from the Better World Scouting Framework to youth members and adult leaders.
 - Provide support to members to join the networks of the Better World Framework initiatives and other communication links.
 - Share and promote resource material relating to Better World Framework activities being made available to all levels of the Movement through appropriate communication channels.
 - To encourage the participation of youth members and Leaders of Queensland Branch of the Better World Framework initiatives.
 - Promote contact between members of the Movement in Queensland and members of the various Better World Framework initiatives, nationally and overseas.
 - Perform other specific duties as requested by the Branch Commissioner International.

CRITERIA

- Have a sound knowledge and strong commitment to the purpose, objectives, and philosophy of Scouting, its policies and procedures and have a clear understanding of the methods which make it distinctive from other youth organisations.
- Be enthusiastic and able to motivate, build, lead, and chair teams among both youth and adults.
- Be inclusive in leadership style.
- Be respectful of all members of their team (and of those in the wider community) recognising individual differences as a resource.
- Be able to communicate effectively with all levels in Scouting and be an accomplished public speaker to the community.
- Be able to mediate, carry out reviews, write reports, and make recommendations.
- Have a sound understanding of the use of technology, information systems, communication and video conferencing to achieve the outcomes of the role.
- Proven ability to prioritise workloads and multitask to ensure commitments are fulfilled in a timely manner.

ROLE SPECIFIC CRITERIA

- Hold a Program Support Leader (Leader of Adults) Wood Badge or be prepared to complete Program support Leader



Proficiency training within 12 months and the Wood Badge training within three years of appointment

- Have a good Working knowledge of WOSM's Better World Scouting Framework with a clear understanding of its impact in Scouting
