Special Interest Award (SIA)

Theme: Performing Arts (Entertainer) Section: Rover Scout (Approx. 16hours)

The challenge of the performing arts: honesty, confidence, and expression, all words that define a Scout.

You should be aiming to work towards this badge over 6 to 12 months.

How to earn your badge:

1. Demonstrate involvement and improvement in a creative activity of your choice:
 - a. Show evidence (reflection notes) of your improvement over a period of. Examples of possible activities include:
 - i. taking part in a show
 - ii. being part of a stage crew working the lighting, sound or creating and moving props
 - iii. dancing
 - iv. being a member of a band
 - b. Take on a leadership role, Examples of possible ways:
 - i. Leadership Team (PL, APL)
 - ii. Production team member – choreography, music etc.
 - iii. Team leader
 - c. Perform or exhibit the activity to an audience
